HINTS FOR SHOWING CUT FLOWERS: A rose should, if possible, have a strong stem with healthy foliage (preference two sets of leaves) and the bloom, with no side bud, should look up. A rose in full bloom should show a stamen. A rose of any other colour is mauve, apricot, gold or multi-coloured. A rose in three stages: bud should show very little colour, next rose half open and three quarters open to full bloom, on separate stems.

ROSES

1. Rose in full bloom
2. Red rose
3. Pink rose
4. Yellow rose
5. White rose
6. Apricot shades rose
7. Miniature rose - one cut
8. Miniature rose - one bloom
9. Rose in three stages
10. Collection of Floribunda rose - one variety, any colour
11. Collection of Iceberg roses - one colour: pink, white or burgundy

OTHER CUT FLOWERS

12. Chrysanthemum - any one cut
13. Chrysanthemum - one or more variety
14. Collection of flowering creeper - one variety
15. Double bougainvillea
16. Single bougainvillea
17. Bougainvillea - variegated foliage or flower
18. Zinnia - any one cut
19. Zinnia - collection, one or more variety
20. Native flower - one or more variety
21. Geranium - one or more variety, foliage optional
22. Marigold - one or more variety
23. Cut flower, not mentioned elsewhere
