

SECTION J – DOG SPORTS

Current Veterinary Vaccination Certificate (3 in 1 vaccination is the minimum level) or Titres Certificate required.

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00. Entries taken from 9.00 am on Sunday of the Show. Ribbons & cards for first and second prizes. Dogs must be on lead when not competing. Owners are responsible for their dogs at all times. Owners/handlers must pick up any poo after their dogs. Section I – Children’s Pets to follow Dog Sports. The first event will commence at 9.30 am on the Sunday of the Show.

Classes may be changed at the discretion of the Judge on the day. Handlers are reminded to please take care not to drag dogs on lead – this will result in disqualification.

1. **Egg & spoon race** - with dog on lead, handler walks/runs to finish line holding egg with spoon
2. **Shopping race** – 3 items (e.g. plastic chop, egg carton, toy) will be placed on the ground a few metres apart. With the dog on lead, handler will stop at first item, ask the dog to sit or lie down, pick up the item and put it in a shopping bag before moving on – repeat for other items and then proceed to finish line.
3. **Jump, tunnel, jump, table** - dog on lead (or off-lead if can be well controlled). Dogs with handler by their side will go over a small jump, through a tunnel, over another small jump and then up onto a low table. (no dragging dog on lead – this will result in disqualification).
4. **Recall race** – dog at start line and handler near finish line, handler calls dog and it races to the finish line. Handler can use treats or toys to entice their dog, as well as calling.
5. **Best stay** – Dogs will be asked to stay (stand or sit or lie down) at the start line and the handlers will move away in increments as instructed by the judge. If the dog steps in any direction, they are “out”. Last dog in position is the winner.
6. **Highest number of sits or lie downs in 30 seconds** – treats or toys can be used.
7. **Dog Barrel Race** – Three x 200 L drums on their side on the ground, with dog to run through the barrels in the same clover-leaf pattern as the horse barrel race. Fastest time wins. **First prize: \$100 plus ribbon.**
