PRIZE MONEY: \$5.00 FIRST PLACE IN EACH CLASS

1. Hand Knitted Garment - 5 ply and under
2. Hand Knitted Garment - 8 ply and over
3. Hand Knitted baby's garment
4. Hand Knitted homewares i.e. knee rug, cushions, kitchen or bathroom towel, tea cosy
5. Any fashion article i.e. beanie, booties, scarves, gloves
6. Knitted Article using leftover yarn (at least 5 colours to be used)
7. Any Article Individual/blend of 100% Natural Fibre (*need to have individual labels pinned to them*)
8. Knitted something suitable for a gift i.e. knitted toy, baby rattle, baby booties/bonnets
9. Recycled/Repurposed article i.e. heritage doilies repurposed into clothing, furnishings or clothing. Jumpers re-made into new creations. Ties made into cushions etc.
10. Any Article by a novice exhibitor
11. Recycled/Repurposed article created by a novice exhibitor.
