### **Most Successful Exhibitor in Cattle - JP O'Brien Memorial Trophy.**

Any one breed. Trophy donated by the family of the Late J P O'Brien.

To be awarded on points basis as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points. Champion = 3 points and Reserve Champion = 2 points. Points to be increased 25% in each case where the prize winner is bred by the exhibitor.

2. Pen of 3 Export Feeders, steers/heifers, 400-500kg. 0-2-Teeth

3. Pen of 3 Heavy Steers, Bullocks, 500 kg +, Grass or grain fed, 2-8 Teeth
