TOOTHA TROPHY: To be awarded to the best sheep handler in the opinion of the Judge and the Chief Steward. Points allotted 50% for attendance, 50% for handling. Handlers to be under the age of 25 years on the first day of the Show. Trophy donated by the O'Keeffe family.

Conditions: All rams to be from Accredited Brucellosis Free Flock Certificate to be shown prior to unloading. Sheep must be foot rot free. All sheep must be bred by and be the property of the exhibitor. Poll Merinos are eligible to compete in all Sheep Sections. Date of shearing to be taken into consideration by the Judge when awarding prizes.

The stewards have the right to transfer exhibits to other classes if in the opinion of the Judge, they are not entered in their correct classes. The age of the sheep will be decided by the number of teeth showing, with 2 tooth sheep not showing more than 2 permanent teeth.

Exhibitors must supply their sheep's feed and water containers. Penning of sheep pens in all sections to be allotted by ballot on the afternoon prior to the Show. Early entries would be appreciated to carry out the above

SECTION F- FLOCK BREEDERS

Classes 1-10

Conditions: Registered Stud Breeders, exhibitors of Registered Sheep and other Ram Breeders are not eligible to compete in these classes. A Grass-fed shall mean a sheep that has been grazed at large on any pasture, not artificially fed, it shall not be protected from the weather, clipped, rugged or oiled, but may be crutched, wigged, or polled. Sheep gaining first place awards in each class in this Section can compete in the **OPEN GRASSFED SECTION** and unless beaten, are eligible for the Grand Champion and Junior Champion. All sheep **must be on the ground by 8.00am on the first day of the Show.** **ALL SHEEP MUST COMPLY WITH GRASSFED CONDITIONS AND BE BRED BY THE EXHIBITOR. Positively no late entries.** Judging will commence at 9.00am on the first day. ENTRY FEE 50 cents. Special Classes \$1.00.

Exhibitors must supply their sheep's feed and water containers. Penning of sheep pens in all sections to be allotted by ballot on the afternoon prior to the Show. Early entries would be appreciated to carry out the above.

Conditions: A grassfed shall mean a sheep that has been grazed at large on any pasture, not artificially fed. It shall not be protected from weather, clipped, rugged or oiled, but may be crutched, wigged or polled. Sheep may compete in Class 43 and are eligible for Grand Champion and Junior Champion. All exhibits must be on the ground by 8.00am on the first day of the Show. All sheep to be the property of and bred by the exhibitor.

No sheep can compete in more than one class, except where specially provided. Housed sheep can compete in Class 43 and the Grand Champion and Junior Champions. All exhibits must be on the ground by 12 noon on the first day of the Show. All sheep to be the property of and bred by the Exhibitor. Judging of the Housed Sheep will commence after the completion of the Open Grass-fed Section. **Positively no late entries.**
