Bona fide work of exhibitors.

Exhibits to be at the Show Office by 5.00pm on the Wednesday prior to the Show (6th May).

Exhibitors are required to label (temporarily on the rear of item) the top of item in order for correct display/hanging. Each exhibit must be clearly marked with name, Class and contact phone number. If not, article will be allocated to a class by Judge or Stewards.

Any work deemed unfit for exhibition by either Judges or Stewards will be rejected.

**PRIZE MONEY: \$5.00 FIRST PLACE IN EACH CLASS**

1. Patchwork Cushion - Maximum 50cm x 50cm (present with insert)
2. Patchwork - Predominantly Handmade (can be machine quilted by another)
3. Patchwork - Predominantly Machine Made (can be machine quilted by another)
4. Patchwork - Predominantly Applique Hand and/or Machine Pieced – (can be machine quilted by another)
5. AgShows NSW Quilted Patchwork Competition (*please see rules & regulations below - page 19*)
6. Any Article of Handmade Jewellery- including but not limited to beading, metalwork, enamel etc.
7. Ceramics - Any Article
8. Tie Dye or Shibori Garment or Accessory
9. China Painting - Any Article
10. Folk Art - Any Article
11. Painted or Upholstered Furniture
12. Hand Spun Wool
13. Scrapbooking (All scrapbooking must be submitted in page protectors)
14. Home Made Cards – individual or a set of 3
15. Paper Tole - Any Article
16. Soft Toy
17. Any Article by a Disabled Person
18. Any Article by a Senior Citizen
19. Woodwork - Any Article
20. Recycled - Waste To Art, Any Medium
21. Felting - Any Article
22. Leatherwork - Any Article
23. Metalwork - Any Article
24. Arts and craft article not mentioned elsewhere, created using a kit
25. Decorated apron (judged on decoration - exhibitors can decorate a plain apron or make their apron)

## HANDICRAFTS, PATCHWORK & QUILTING (Continued)

### AgShows NSW QUILTED PATCHWORK COMPETITION - Rules & Regulations

*\*This new competition is currently open to all Shows and Groups to adopt.*

*\* If Group support is sufficient, the RAS will be invited to conduct a State Final.*

- 1. The exhibit needs to fit within a square (1m x 1m) maximum size.*
  - 2. Framed and board mounted exhibits not permitted.*
  - 3. Must be either hand and/or machine pieced and quilted.*
  - 4. Minimal Embellishments. Small amount only not to overpower patchwork.*
  - 5. Each exhibit entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.*
  - 6. An exhibit having won at a Show will compete at a Group Final.*
  - 7. An exhibit is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State level.*
  - 8. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group level, then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.*
  - 9. All work to have been completed in the last twelve (12) months prior to its entry at a local Show.*
  - 10. An exhibit that has previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again.*
  - 11. If this class is not scheduled or attracts no entries at a local Show, the Chief Pavilion Steward in consultation with the appropriate Pavilion Section Judges, may select a suitable quilt and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular Society concerned.*
  - 12. Group Final location and date is to be determined by the Group. It is the responsibility of either the exhibitor or the Show Society to ensure the quilt is delivered on Judging Day and collected in an appropriate time frame after the competition.*
