As an entrant in the competition, you will be required to attend the following events:

- **13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> May 2023 Walgett Show**  
As an ambassador you will be required to assist at the Show e.g. help with gate entry, assist Walgett Show Society committee, help sash and hand out prizes in various sections of the Show
- **8<sup>th</sup> July 2023 Walgett Young Woman Judging** (Luncheon and Judging. More details to follow - *Please note this is a suggested date and may change*)

As an entrant in the Walgett Young Woman Competition, you will undertake a formal interview where you will be judged on the following:

- Personality
- Confidence
- Ambitions/goals
- General knowledge (local and National)
- Rural knowledge (general, local, Show)
- Volunteer/community participation



During the formal interview, three judges will ask you questions that may consist of but not limited to the following:

1. Why did you enter the Walgett Show Young Woman Competition?
2. As a rural ambassador representing your local area, what local rural or urban issue interests you?
3. What is a current issue in Walgett Shire that you feel strongly about and how would you work towards improving it?
4. Why do you think a local Show is important? What are the benefits?
