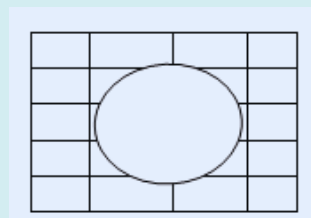

HINTS FOR PRESENTATION OF CROCHET

- No backing to be put on crocheted articles
- Please supply label from yarn used, attached to inside of article
- Fine crocheting yarns numbers #10, #12, #20, #30, #40, #50, #60, #80, #100 (being the finest)
- Thicker crocheting yarns numbered: 3ply, 5ply, 8ply
- Crocheting presents best if it is blocked. To do this, the article should be dampened and then pinned out to the measurements specified in the pattern. Woollen articles should be pressed carefully and then gently pulled into shape, before being stitched together. This also applies to knitted items.
- The best way to block any article is shown below:

For circular items draw a circle on board, centre work and pin edges out to edges of circle:



Blocking Board:

Cover with fabric and mark in equal parts.

Remember to sew loose ends into the back of the work and snip off.

No knots – it is easier and quicker to join a new thread on as you work and sew in the threads later.

The judge will be looking for evenness of tension, for workmanship and for presentation.

1. Garment in natural fibre e.g. knee rug, hat
2. Rug or Cushion
3. Cotton Doily in fine yarn
4. Any Article with crocheted edge
5. Article for Baby
6. Any Fashion Accessory e.g. booties, shawl
7. Something suitable for a gift
8. Recycled/repurposed article e.g. doilies into a doorstep with crochet, clothing etc.
9. Any Article of crochet by a novice exhibitor
10. Recycled/repurposed article made by a novice exhibitor.
