### Conditions:

**Judging commences Friday 5th April, 2024. Fleeces are to reach Wool Pavilion before 3.00pm, Friday 5th April 2024. No late entries will be judged unless prior arrangements are made with the Chief Steward.**

All fleeces must be owned and bred by exhibitor and clearly marked with exhibitor's name and class entered. Fleeces must be grown and/or shorn in current Show season. Fleeces in all classes must be skirted. Judge will make weight deductions for "skirty" fleeces. Society Ribbons will be awarded for class placings. Award cards and Ribbons for Trophy classes. The Judge has the right to reclassify any fleece. Spinners type fleeces from Tableland's area must be entered in Class 1. Housed, Semi-housed and rugged: fleeces must be entered in Classes 2 and 3. All fleeces eligible for one class only. For stud breeders 3b Merino Rams Fleece - 6 month shearing 80mm and under.

**Registered Studs and other Ram Breeders ineligible to compete in Flock Classes.** Wool from pets eligible in pet class only. **All fleeces from Classes 1-13 eligible for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Award and Champion Flock Fleece.**

Trophy presentation second day of the Show in the Wool Pavilion.

NOTE: All fleeces to be picked up by 6.00pm on the second day of the Show. All remaining fleeces will be donated to the Show Society unless other arrangements have been made with the Chief Steward.

N.B. All fleeces entered, except for classes 4. and 17., will be Laserscan Micron tested for classification and judging purposes.
