HINTS FOR SHOWING CUT FLOWERS

A rose should, if possible, have a long strong stem with healthy foliage (preference two sets of leaves) and the bloom, with no side bud, should look up. A rose in full bloom should show a stamen. Rose of any other colour, is mauve, apricot, gold or multi-coloured. Rose in three stages, bud should show very little colour, next rose half open and three quarters open to full bloom, on separate stems.
